The following House Files were introduced:

Howard introduced:

H. F. No. 3327, A bill for an act relating to taxation; local government aids; making class 4d(1) low-income rental property aid permanent; appropriating money; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 477A.

The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Taxes.

Hollins and Backer introduced:

H. F. No. 3328, A bill for an act relating to education; requiring the Department of Education to bring awareness of library services for blind and print disabled persons; amending Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 134.31, subdivisions 4a, 6.

The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Education Policy.

Hudson introduced:

H. F. No. 3329, A bill for an act relating to judiciary; assigning public defender in criminal prosecution to civil forfeiture litigation; staying civil forfeiture litigation until after criminal prosecution; amending Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 609.531, subdivision 6a.

The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Judiciary Finance and Civil Law.
