The following House Files were introduced:

Gillman and Skraba introduced:

H. F. No. 2150, A bill for an act relating to solid waste; requiring surety bond for tire collectors; amending Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 115A.902, by adding a subdivision.

The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Environment and Natural Resources Finance and Policy.

Wolgamott introduced:

H. F. No. 2151, A bill for an act relating to higher education; establishing a plant-based foods production training pilot program; appropriating money; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 136A.

The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Higher Education Finance and Policy.

Rehrauer introduced:

H. F. No. 2152, A bill for an act relating to education finance; increasing state total adult basic education aid; modifying the adult basic education program aid limit; increasing funding to pay the costs of commissioner-selected high school equivalency tests; appropriating money; amending Minnesota Statutes 2024, sections 124D.531, subdivisions 1, 4; 124D.55.

The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Education Finance.
