The following House Files were introduced:

Sanders and Nelson introduced:

H. F. No. 2303, A bill for an act relating to legislative enactments; correcting miscellaneous oversights, inconsistencies, ambiguities, unintended results, and technical errors; amending Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 62L.02, subdivision 11.

The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Rules and Legislative Administration.

Howe introduced:

H. F. No. 2304, A bill for an act relating to capital investment; appropriating money for capital improvements and betterments at military affairs facilities statewide; authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds.

The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on State Government Finance.

Kresha introduced:

H. F. No. 2305, A bill for an act relating to capital investment; appropriating money for rehabilitation of the Soo Line Trail bridge in Morrison County; authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds.

The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Environment and Natural Resources Policy and Finance.

Clark introduced:

H. F. No. 2306, A bill for an act relating to state government; providing for disposition and use of Capitol restoration marble; appropriating money.
