Appropriates \$250,000 in fiscal year 2022 and \$250,000 in fiscal year 2023 for a grant to the Minnesota School-Based Health Alliance for grants.

**Subd. 1. Appropriation.** Requires grants be used to ensure entities providing school-based health center services meet definition of a school-based health center, participate in state interagency dialogue on school-based and linked health care, participate in planning and funding interagency health and education equity priorities, and develop strategic interagency partnerships.

**Subd. 2. Definitions.** Defines terms including “comprehensive school-based health center,” “sponsoring organizations or sponsoring facilities,” and “Minnesota School-Based Health Alliance.”

**Subd. 3. Services provided.** Requires services to be provided to all students within a school regardless of ability to pay. Allows a school-based health center to serve students from other public schools, family members, and the community at large.

**Subd. 4. SBHC operation.** Requires a comprehensive school-based health center to be administered by a sponsoring facility in partnership with the school, provide primary health services through licensed and qualified health professionals, establish a relationship with one or more schools in the community, and collaborate and consult with one or more partnering organizations.
