1.16 Page 5, delete section 3

1.17 Page 6, lines 12 and 13, reinstate the stricken language

1.18 Page 6, line 14, before the period, insert "using the individual provider's certification
1.19 anniversary or the calendar year end, whichever is later. The commissioner may approve a
1.20 recertification extension, in the interest of sustaining services, when a certain date for
1.21 recertification is identified"

1.22 Page 6, after line 19, insert:

1.23 "(b) The commissioner must provide the following to providers for the certification,
1.24 recertification, and decertification processes:

- 2.1 (1) a structured listing of required provider certification criteria;
- 2.2 (2) a formal written letter with a determination of certification, recertification, or
- 2.3 decertification, signed by the commissioner or the appropriate division director; and
- 2.4 (3) a formal written communication outlining the process for necessary corrective action
- 2.5 and follow-up by the commissioner, if applicable."

2.6 Page 6, line 20, strike "(b)" and insert "(c)"

2.7 Page 10, delete section 7

2.8 Page 12, line 13, strike the comma

2.9 Page 12, line 14, strike the comma in both places

2.10 Page 12, line 15, before the period, insert "or the provider determines that psychotherapy

2.11 is no longer medically necessary. When a provider determines that psychotherapy is no

2.12 longer medically necessary, the provider must update required documentation, including

2.13 but not limited to the individual treatment plan, the child's medical record, or other

2.14 authorizations, to include the determination"

2.15 Page 13, line 25, strike "and individual behavior plan"

2.16 Renumber the sections in sequence

2.17 Correct the title numbers accordingly

2.18 With the recommendation that when so amended the bill be returned to the Committee

2.19 on Human Services Finance and Policy.
