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## MLFCCA Position on SF6/HF57 Universal Preschool for all four-year olds.

MLFCCA opposes Universal Preschool.

- Universal Preschool is a movement in direct conflict with research that
  continues to amplify the importance of early childhood play-based learning
  environments, like family child care, that support children's interests and
  natural curiosities with time to explore and experience learning at their
  individual pace and level of development.
- Universal Preschool does not address the need to fund research that specifically
  cites in what type of care setting the children who are not prepared for
  kindergarten have been in order to appropriately target funding.
- Based on the current adult-to-child ratio, Universal Preschool will significantly impact the sustainability of the licensed family child care profession, which has lost significant numbers of providers since 2011.
- Universal Preschool will force a market change that will negatively impact and create a financial burden for families seeking care for children birth to 3 as family child care programs will be forced to raise rates to earn a sustainable operating income.
