

# Bill Walk Through

# Operations & Technical Changes

<u>Section 1:</u> Moves TOCAIT reporting duties to MDE. PELSB and OHE will collaborate.

<u>Sections 2-4:</u> Move the voluntary paraprofessional credential to MDE, in alignment with their jurisdiction over non-licensed school staff.

<u>Section 5:</u> Removes reference to outdated InTASC standards in favor of current standards. It also removes an obsolete reporting requirement.

Section 6: Removes redundant language.

<u>Section 7:</u> Removes requirement for Tier 1 teachers to take, but not pass, content exams before renewal.

## **Grants Administration**

<u>Section 8:</u> Moves administration of the Collaborative Urban and Greater MN Educators of Color (CUGMEC) Grant to MDE.

<u>Sections 9-13:</u> Move administration of the Teacher Mentorship & Retention of Effective Teachers Grant to MDE.

<u>Section 14:</u> Aligns the alternative teacher preparation grant reporting requirement with grant administration.

## **Grants Administration**


Section 15: Transfers PELSB's grantmaking duties and staff to MDE.

<u>Section 16:</u> Transfers appropriations for the CUGMEC Grant, Teacher Mentorship & Retention of Effective Teachers Grant, and the Teacher Recruitment Marketing Campaign Grant to MDE.

Provides one-time funding for IT and 1 ongoing FTE to the Board of School Administrators to enable the Board to issue administrative licenses.

# Funding Alternative Pathways to Licensure

#### Section 17:

- Increases operations funds to cover staff salaries;
- funds portfolio review;
- funds the heritage language pathway program;
- funds alternative pathway programs (portfolio cohorts); and
- funds the online portfolio platform.

Interest in portfolio and alternative pathways has grown significantly over the past two years.

**Recommendation:** SF 1462 does not include an appropriation for the Preparation Pathways Grant Program as that work is now conducted by staff funded under section 17.
