The EquaSpace Model

Reimagining How We Work

- In 2024, we developed a first of its kind in the Twin Cities, 16,000+/sf center in Saint Paul's Court International Building for a group of local nonprofits that focus largely on systems change work. EquaSpace at Court, aka, EquaSpace 1, opened its doors in October of 2024 and is now at capacity, housing 25 organizations and their 150+ employees.
- EquaSpace 2 and 3, which will be located in Minneapolis and Saint Paul, will each support 40-50 nonprofits that broadly serve children and families with an array of services that aim to ensure they are equipped with the resources and programs for long-term success.
