Bill Description

This bill updates the Minnesota Board of Optometry Practice Act. It is a technical bill to modify outdated statutes, codify fees into statutes and deletes them from rules, and updates the Grounds for Discipline to replicate other similar health licensing board statutes.

Section by Section Review:

Section 1 Board of optometry. Amends § 148.52. Clarifies that optometrists who are appointed to

the board must be licensed in Minnesota.

Section 2 Board; seal. Amends § 148.54. Adds the offices of vice president and secretary to the

board.

Section 3 License. Amends § 148.57. Strikes the application and endorsement fees. Strikes cross references

to sections repealed in this bill. Strikes subdivisions 3 (revocation, suspension) and 4 (peddling or canvassing forbidden). Adds subdivision 5. Requires a regulated person to maintain a current name and address with the board and notify the board in writing within 30 days of any change. Requires a regulated person to request revised credentials from the board when the person has a name change. Establishes requirements for reissuance of lost, stolen, or destroyed credentials.

Section 4 Prohibitions relating to legend drugs. Amends § 148.574. Strikes references to sections

repealed in this bill ..

Section 5 Requirement for use of legend drugs. Amends § 148.575. Strikes subdivisions 1 (certificate required for use of legend drugs), 3 (display of certificate required), 5 (notice to Board of Pharmacy), and 6 (board certification required). Strikes obsolete language related to board certification for use of legend drugs since the use of legend drugs is now part of the curriculum in optometric training.

Section 6 Standard of care. Amends § 148.577. Strikes reference to a section repealed in this bill..

Section 7 License and registration fees. Amends § 148.59. Establishes fees. Provides that fees may not exceed the listed amounts, but may be adjusted lower by the board.

Section 8 Grounds for disciplinary action. Amends § 148.603. Establishes the conduct that may be the basis for disciplinary action. The grounds reflect best practices as currently in statute for other Health Licensing Boards.

Section 9 Reporting obligations. Creates § 148.604. .

Section 10 Immunity. Creates § 148.605. Subd. 1. Reporting. Provides that any individual or entity making a report under section 148.604 in good faith and in exercise of reasonable care is immune from criminal and civil liability.

Assumptions

The board would anticipate implementation on August 1, 2015.

• No fiscal impact is anticipated as result of sections 1-6 and 8-10 of the bill.

Assumptions specific to the Revenue Table:

• The current number paying is based on the prior five year average for each category. All numbers are set on those averages with the exception of licensees which have a net increase of approximately 15-20 Optometrists per year.

• Future revenue estimates assume that board fees are set at the not to exceed amounts identified in the bill. The not to exceed numbers can be lowered as the Board desires to maintain a minimum reserve or the six month surplus. It will review the fee schedule once legislation is passed and set the actual fee schedule at the September, 2015 meeting. Preliminary discussion would maintain the current annual renewal of license charge to the Optometrist at \$115.00 as the surcharge fee is being sunset on June 30, 2015.

• To implement the new fee tables, a modest expenditure of not to exceed \$1000.00 for updating web services, data base and forms would be incurred. It is anticipated that implementation expense would be absorbed within current operations.

• The fees associated with old statutes (TPA, DPA) are removed and those fees are combined with a single application fee.
