1.9 \$2,800,000 the second year is a onetime
1.10 appropriation.

1.11 \$2,300,000 the second year is from the state
1.12 parks account in the natural resources fund.

1.13 Of this amount, \$1,300,000 is onetime, of
1.14 which \$1,150,000 is for strategic park
1.15 acquisition.

1.16 \$20,000 the second year is from the natural
1.17 resources fund to design and erect signs
1.18 marking the David Dill trail designated in this
1.19 act. Of this amount, \$10,000 is from the
1.20 snowmobile trails and enforcement account
1.21 and \$10,000 is from the all-terrain vehicle
1.22 account. This is a onetime appropriation.

1.23 \$100,000 the second year is for the
1.24 improvement of the infrastructure for sanitary
1.25 sewer service at the Woodenfrog Campground

2.1 in Kabetogama State Forest. This is a onetime
2.2 appropriation.

2.3 \$29,000 the second year is for computer
2.4 programming related to the transfer-on-death
2.5 title changes for watercraft. This is a onetime
2.6 appropriation.

2.7 \$210,000 the first year is from the water
2.8 recreation account in the natural resources
2.9 fund for implementation of Minnesota
2.10 Statutes, section 86B.532, established in this
2.11 act. This is a onetime appropriation. The
2.12 commissioner of natural resources shall seek
2.13 federal and other nonstate funds to reimburse
2.14 the department for the initial costs of
2.15 producing and distributing carbon monoxide
2.16 boat warning labels. All amounts collected
2.17 under this paragraph shall be deposited into
2.18 the water recreation account.

2.19 \$1,000,000 the second year is from the natural
2.20 resources fund for a grant to Lake County for
2.21 construction, including bridges, of the
2.22 Prospectors ATV Trail System linking the
2.23 communities of Ely, Babbitt, Embarrass, and
2.24 Tower; Bear Head Lake and Lake
2.25 Vermilion-Soudan Underground Mine State
2.26 Parks; the Taconite State Trail; and the Lake
2.27 County Regional ATV Trail System. Of this
2.28 amount, \$900,000 is from the all-terrain
2.29 vehicle account, \$50,000 is from the
2.30 off-highway motorcycle account, and \$50,000
2.31 is from the off-road vehicle account. This is
2.32 a onetime appropriation and is available until
2.33 June 30, 2019."
