Overview

This bill sets requirements to remove identifying insignia and equipment before a law enforcement vehicle is sold or transferred to the general public and provides for civil penalties for a violation. Effective August 1, 2026.

| 1 | <p>[Adds § 169.981] Sale or transfer of law enforcement vehicle.</p> <p>Sets limitations on sale or transfer of a law enforcement vehicle and provides for violations.</p> <p>Subd. 1. Definition. Defines “law enforcement vehicle” for the section.</p> <p>Subd. 2. Prohibition. Prohibits sale or transfer of a law enforcement vehicle that is equipped with emergency or public safety equipment and insignia that could misleadingly identify it as a law enforcement vehicle.</p> <p>Subd. 3. Certificate of compliance. Requires a certificate of compliance accompanying sale or transfer of a law enforcement vehicle. Directs the Department of Public Safety to design the certificate and make it available online without charge.</p> <p>Subd. 4. Violations. Establishes liability and civil penalties for sale or transfer of a law enforcement vehicle in violation of the marking and equipment limitations.</p> <p>Subd. 5. Enforcement. Provides explicit authority for county and city attorneys to bring a civil lawsuit for a violation of this section.</p> <p>Subd. 6. Exemption. Creates an exemption for vehicles registered as a collector’s item.</p> |
