1.17 **Subdivision 1. Minnesota Humanities Center.** (a) These amounts are appropriated to
1.18 the Board of Directors of the Minnesota Humanities Center for grants to the named
1.19 organizations for the purposes specified in this subdivision. The Minnesota Humanities
1.20 Center may use up to five percent of this appropriation for costs that are directly related to
1.21 and necessary to the administration of grants in this subdivision.

1.22 (b) Grant agreements entered into by the Minnesota Humanities Center and recipients
1.23 of appropriations under this subdivision must ensure that money appropriated in this
1.24 subdivision is used to supplement and not substitute for traditional sources of funding.

2.1 (c) All appropriations in this article are onetime and available until June 20, 2020.

2.2 (d) \$500,000 in fiscal year 2019 is appropriated from the arts and cultural heritage fund
2.3 to the Minnesota Humanities Center for the purpose of supporting the work of the Women's
2.4 Suffrage 100th Anniversary Commemoration Commission, including grants for educational
2.5 and civic events.

2.6 Subd. 2. **Department of Administration.** (a) These amounts are appropriated to the
2.7 commissioner of administration for grants to the named organizations for the purposes
2.8 specified in this subdivision. The commissioner of administration may use a portion of this
2.9 appropriation for costs that are directly related to and necessary to the administration of
2.10 grants in this subdivision.

2.11 (b) Grant agreements entered into by the commissioner and recipients of appropriations
2.12 under this subdivision must ensure that money appropriated in this subdivision is used to
2.13 supplement and not substitute for traditional sources of funding.

2.14 (c) All appropriations in this article are onetime.

2.15 (d) \$300,000 in fiscal year 2019 is appropriated from the arts and cultural heritage fund
2.16 to the commissioner of administration for a grant to the Lake Superior Center Authority to
2.17 develop, prepare, and construct an exhibit on river systems to help educate Minnesotans on
2.18 how to protect, enhance, and restore water quality in Minnesota rivers.

2.19 (e) \$150,000 in fiscal year 2019 is appropriated from the arts and cultural heritage fund
2.20 to the commissioner of administration for a grant to the Minnesota China Friendship Garden
2.21 Society to plan and design portions of the Chinese garden project in Phalen Park in St. Paul.

2.22 (f) \$60,000 in fiscal year 2019 is appropriated from the arts and cultural heritage fund
2.23 to the commissioner of administration for staffing the Capitol Art Exhibit Advisory
2.24 Committee as directed under Minnesota Statutes, section 15B.36. The commissioner may
2.25 enter into an interagency agreement with the Minnesota State Arts Board to help perform
2.26 duties related to soliciting art and art proposals, art curation, and promotion of recommended
2.27 and approved exhibits in the Capitol building. This appropriation is available for use until
2.28 December 31, 2019.

2.29 (g) \$50,000 in fiscal year 2019 is appropriated from the arts and cultural heritage fund
2.30 to the commissioner of administration for a grant to the Association of Minnesota Public
2.31 Educational Radio Stations for statewide programming to promote the Veterans' Voices
2.32 program to educate and engage communities regarding veterans' contributions, knowledge,
2.33 skills, and experiences with an emphasis on Korean War veterans.

3.1 Subd. 3. Minnesota Historical Society. (a) These amounts are appropriated to the
3.2 governing board of the Minnesota Historical Society for grants to the named organizations
3.3 for the purposes specified in this subdivision. The Minnesota Historical Society may use a
3.4 portion of this appropriation for costs that are directly related to and necessary to the
3.5 administration of grants in this subdivision.

3.6 (b) Grant agreements entered into by the Minnesota Historical society and recipients of
3.7 appropriations under this subdivision must ensure that money appropriated in this subdivision
3.8 is used to supplement and not substitute for traditional sources of funding.

3.9 (c) All appropriations in this article are onetime.

3.10 (d) \$150,000 in fiscal year 2019 is appropriated from the arts and cultural heritage fund
3.11 to the Minnesota Historical Society for a grant to the Preston Historical Society for the
3.12 Preston grain elevator restoration and recreation project.

3.13 (e) \$100,000 in fiscal year 2019 is appropriated from the arts and cultural heritage fund
3.14 to the Minnesota Historical Society for a grant to the Greater Litchfield Opera House
3.15 Association to repair and update the electrical capabilities and interior walls in the Litchfield
3.16 Opera House.

3.17 (f) \$10,000 in fiscal year 2019 is appropriated from the arts and cultural heritage fund
3.18 to the Minnesota Historical Society for a grant to the city of Grove City for the Grove City
3.19 Mill restoration."
