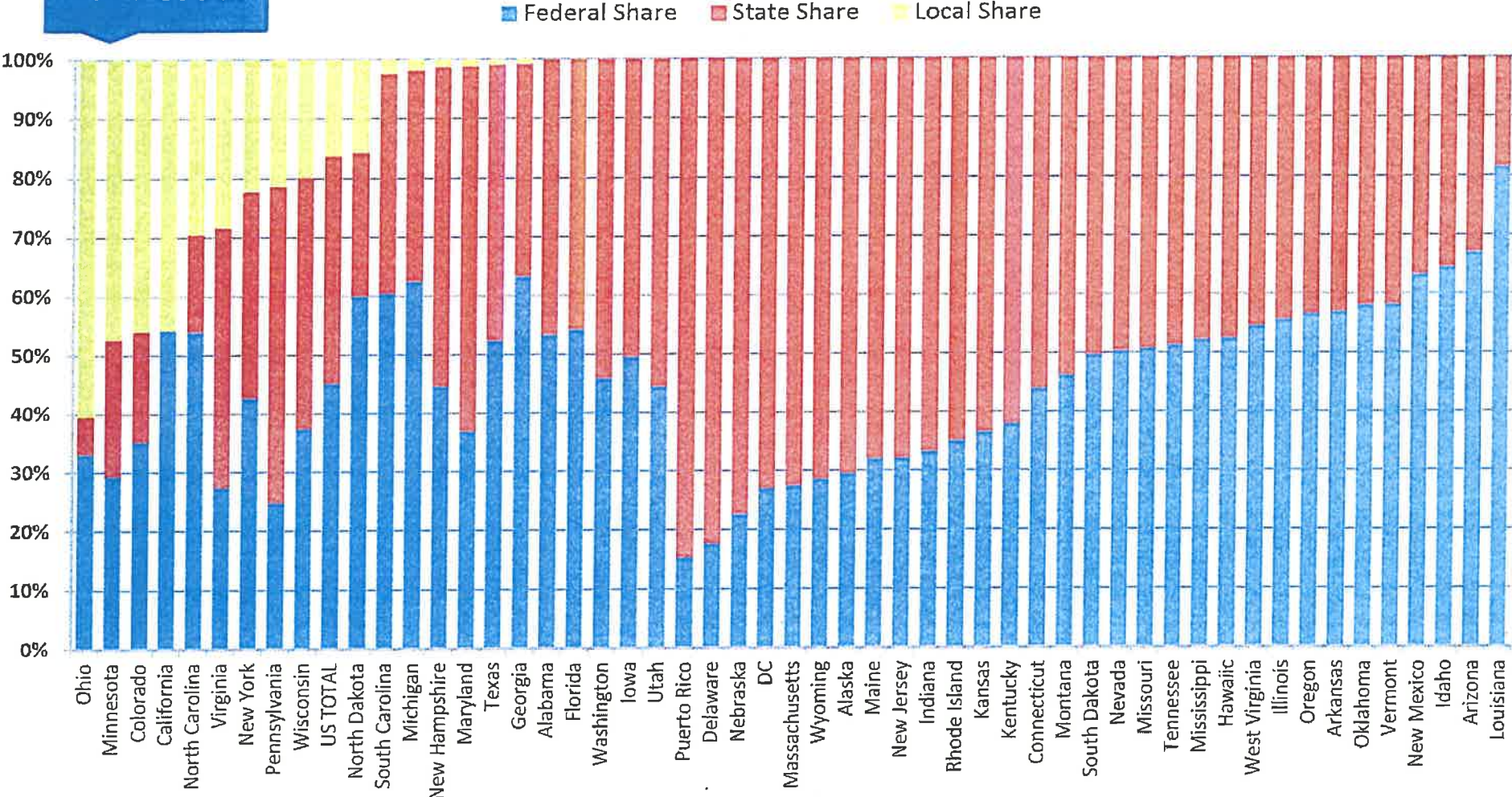


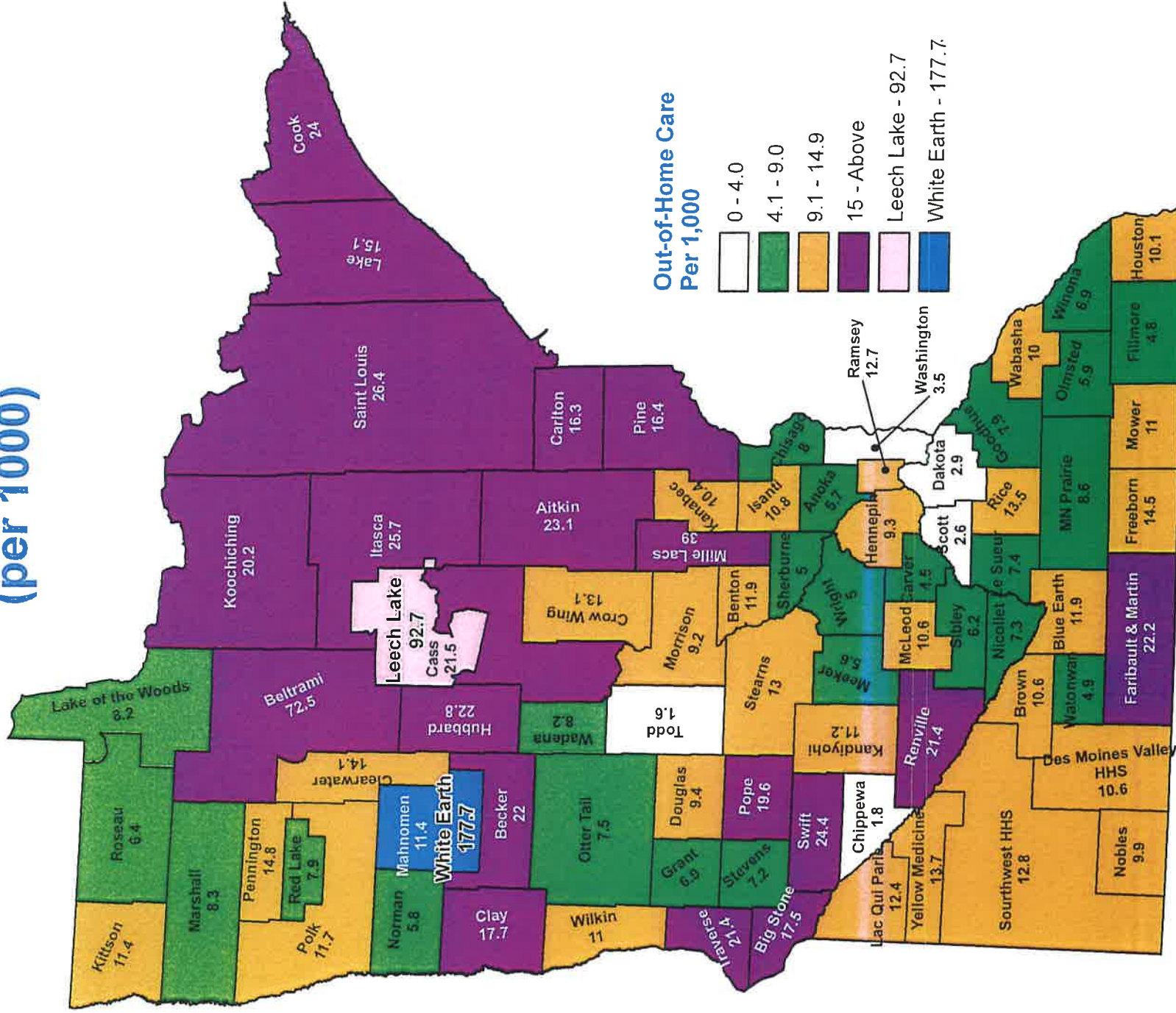

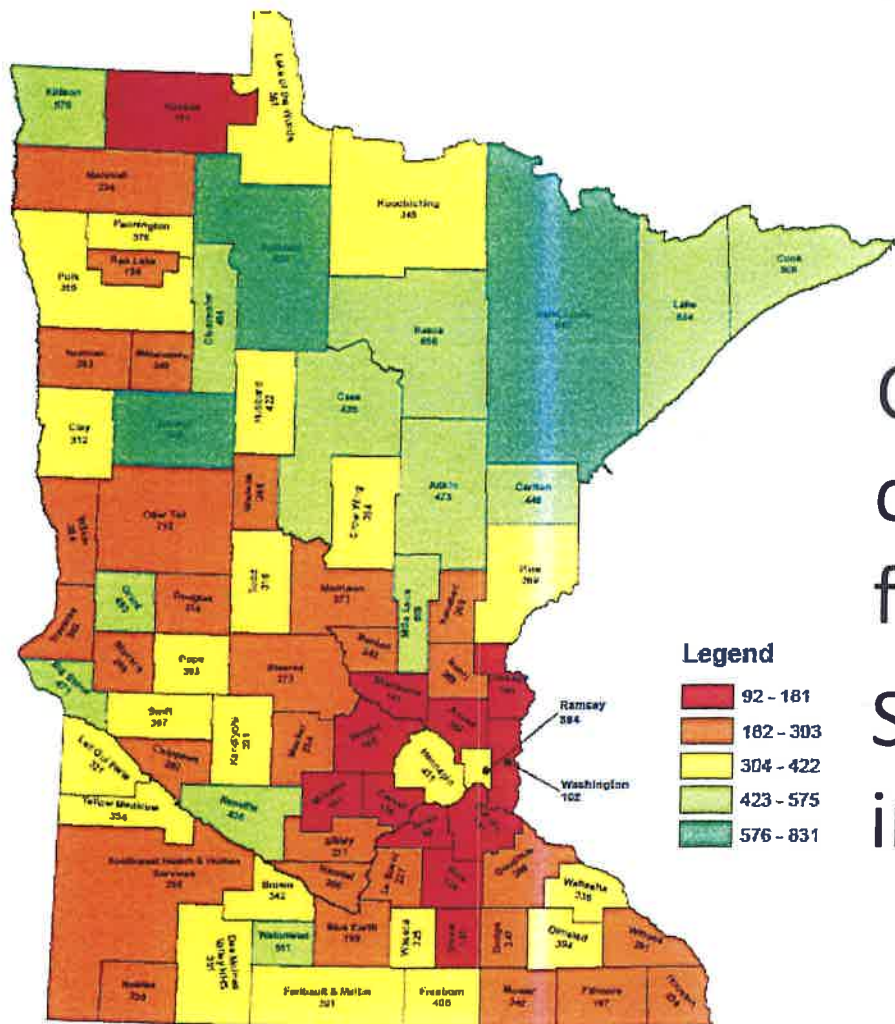

There are no intercensal population estimates for Indian reservations. These numbers represent the 2010 U.S. Census for children residing on the Leech Lake and White Earth reservations and who indicated American Indian alone or as one of two or more races. The Leech Lake reservation has land in Cass, Itasca, Beltrami and Hubbard counties. The White Earth reservation overlaps Mahnommen, Becker and Clearwater counties. Note: Southwest Health and Human Services includes: Lincoln, Lyon, Murray, Rock, Pipestone and Redwood counties. Des Moines Valley Health and Human Services includes: Cottonwood and Jackson counties.
