## Overview

This bill assigns responsibility for prosecuting crimes arising from peace-officer-involved deaths to the attorney general.

## Summary

Section	Description
1	<b>Appearance.</b> Creates an exception to the attorney general's limited prosecutorial role to reflect that the attorney general will prosecute crimes arising out of peace-officer-involved deaths as provided for in section 2.
2	<b>Peace-officer-involved deaths.</b> Directs the attorney general to prosecute crimes arising out of peace-officer-involved deaths.
3	<b>General provisions.</b> Contains a conforming amendment to the county attorney jurisdiction statute to account for the transfer of peace-officer-involved death cases to the attorney general.
4	<b>Appropriation.</b> Appropriates an unspecified amount to the attorney general to fund the prosecutions of peace-officer-involved death cases.
