follows: 1.2 On R119-A3, Senate language, (UEH2128-1) 1.3 Page 110, lines 7 and 8, delete the new language and strike the old language 1.4 Page 110, line 9, delete the new language 1.5 Page 110, line 10, delete the new language and strike the old language 1.6 Page 110, lines 11 to 14, strike the old language 1.7 Page 110, after line 14, insert: 1.8 "(12) food served at fund-raisers, community events or fellowship meals conducted in 1.9 the building or on the grounds of a faith-based organization, provided that a certified food 1.10 manager or volunteer trained in a food safety course, trains the food preparation workers 1.11 in safe food handling practices. Food prepared during these events is allowed to be made 1.12 available for curbside pickup or delivered to members of the faith-based organization or 1.13 the community in which the faith-based organization serves.
