Overview

Appropriates an unspecified amount in fiscal year 2019 from the general fund to the commissioner of human services for school-linked mental health services. Requires at least 25 percent of the funding to be directed to providers serving special education students who are from families with high poverty or who are receiving services in the Emotional and Behavioral Disorder (EBD) category. Requires the grants to be awarded to providers serving students in both metro and rural areas.

Appropriation; school-linked mental health grants. Appropriates an unspecified amount of money from the general fund in fiscal year 2019 to the commissioner of human services for grants to providers of school-linked mental health services to students served by Minnesota school districts.
