1.12 of whom must be volunteer firefighters and one of whom may be a ~~career~~ full-time firefighter,

1.14 (2) two members representing the Minnesota State Fire Chiefs Association, one of whom
1.15 must be a volunteer fire chief, appointed by the governor;

1.16 (3) two members representing the Minnesota Professional Firefighters Association,
1.17 appointed by the governor;

1.18 (4) two members representing Minnesota home rule charter and statutory cities, appointed
1.19 by the governor;

1.20 (5) two members representing Minnesota towns, appointed by the governor;

1.21 (6) the commissioner of public safety or the commissioner's designee; and

2.1 (7) one public member not affiliated or associated with any member or interest represented
 2.2 in clauses (1) to (6), appointed by the governor.

2.3 The Minnesota State Fire Department Association shall recommend five persons to be the
 2.4 members described in clause (1), the Minnesota State Fire Chiefs Association shall
 2.5 recommend two persons to be the members described in clause (2), the Minnesota
 2.6 Professional Firefighters Association shall recommend two persons to be the members
 2.7 described in clause (3), the League of Minnesota Cities shall recommend two persons to be
 2.8 the members described in clause (4), and the Minnesota Association of Townships shall
 2.9 recommend two persons to be the members described in clause (5). In making the
 2.10 appointments the governor shall try to achieve representation from all geographic areas of
 2.11 the state."

3.3 Subd. 7. **Duties of chief firefighting officer.** (a) Every chief firefighting officer has a
3.4 duty to ensure that every full-time firefighter has a license issued by the board.

3.5 (b) Every chief firefighting officer, or designee, has the duty to verify that every full-time
3.6 and volunteer individual applying, reinstating, or renewing a license is affiliated with a
3.7 Minnesota fire department.

3.8 ~~(b)~~ (c) Every chief firefighting officer, provider, and individual licensee has a duty to
3.9 ensure proper training records and reports are retained. Records must include, for the
3.10 three-year period subsequent to the license renewal date:
