- Subject Board of Medical Practice technical and policy changes
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Overview

This bill makes technical and policy changes to statutes governing physician, physician assistant, and acupuncture licensure and practice.

Summary

Section Description

1 United States or Canadian medical school graduates.

Amends § 147.02, subd. 1. Removes language regarding alternative graduate medical training approved by the board but not accredited by a national accrediting organization.

2 Endorsement; reciprocity.

Amends § 147.03, subd. 1. Makes technical and clarifying changes; removes minimum score of 75 for the Special Purpose Examination of the Federation of State Medical Boards; adds the Comprehensive Osteopathic Medical Licensing Examination.

3 **Requirements.**

Amends § 147.037, subd. 1. Makes clarifying changes; specifies acceptable osteopathic licensing examinations.

4 Forms of disciplinary action.

Amends § 147.141. Makes technical changes.

5 **Forms of disciplinary action.**

Amends § 147A.16. Makes technical changes.

Section Description

6 Exceptions.

Amends § 147B.02, subd. 4. Removes language that allows an intern or person studying in an approved formal course of study, if supervised by a licensed acupuncturist, to practice acupuncture without an acupuncture license.

7 Licensure requirements.

Amends § 147B.02, subd. 7. Makes technical and clarifying changes; removes requirement for a notarized copy of an applicant's National Certification Commission for Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine certification.

8 Repealer.

Repeals Minnesota Rules, parts 5610.0100; 5610.0200; and 5610.0300 (relating to professional corporations).



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
