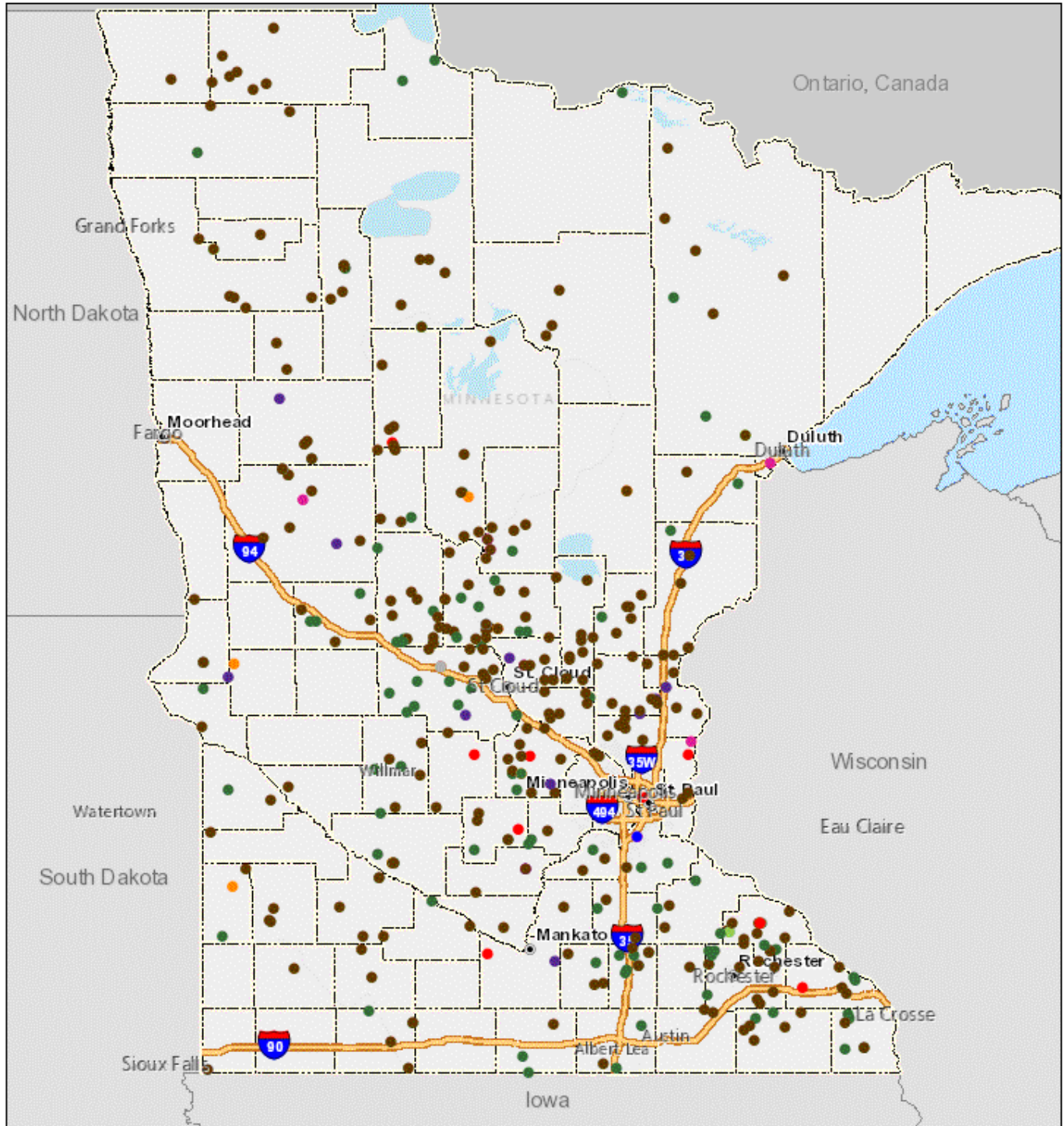
**Number tested for CWD: 896**

\*\*The testing will increase this fall until the end of the year with more animals being harvested at that time of year.



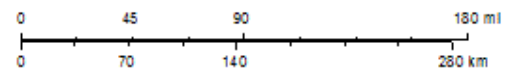
# Farmed Cervid Herds in Minnesota by Species

## HERD CANCELLATIONS

Eight herds have been canceled to date in 2019: five herds depopulated, one herd has signed a compliance agreement, and two herds are pending outcome.

## CROW WING COUNTY CWD-INFECTED HERD DEPOPULATION

Herd depopulated April 16, 2019. A total of 102 carcasses were removed from the property.

CWD test results completed May 7, 2019:

- 91 animals tested – 82 negative / 7 positive / 2 unsuitable.
- 11 animals untestable. Some of the animals died on the farm before the start of the USDA depopulation. Those carcasses didn't have adequate material to be sampled for CWD testing.

Site cleaned and decontaminated.

## CWD SAMPLE COLLECTOR AUTHORIZATION

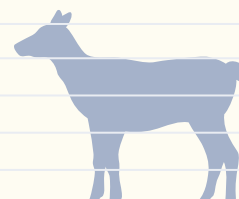
Three components:

1. Classroom training.
  2. Sample collection demo by field staff if collector has insufficient history of successful sample collection (meaning tissues were successfully tested at the lab).
  3. Submit samples from two animals to the Minnesota Veterinary Diagnostic Laboratory for testing by the end of the calendar year with successful test results (Not Detected, Suspect, or Positive are successful test results / Location, Unsuitable, Unacceptable are unsuccessful test results).
- 221 people have attended the classroom trainings offered in April, May and August.
  - 80 people have completed all the necessary components and have been notified they are Board Authorized CWD Sample Collectors.

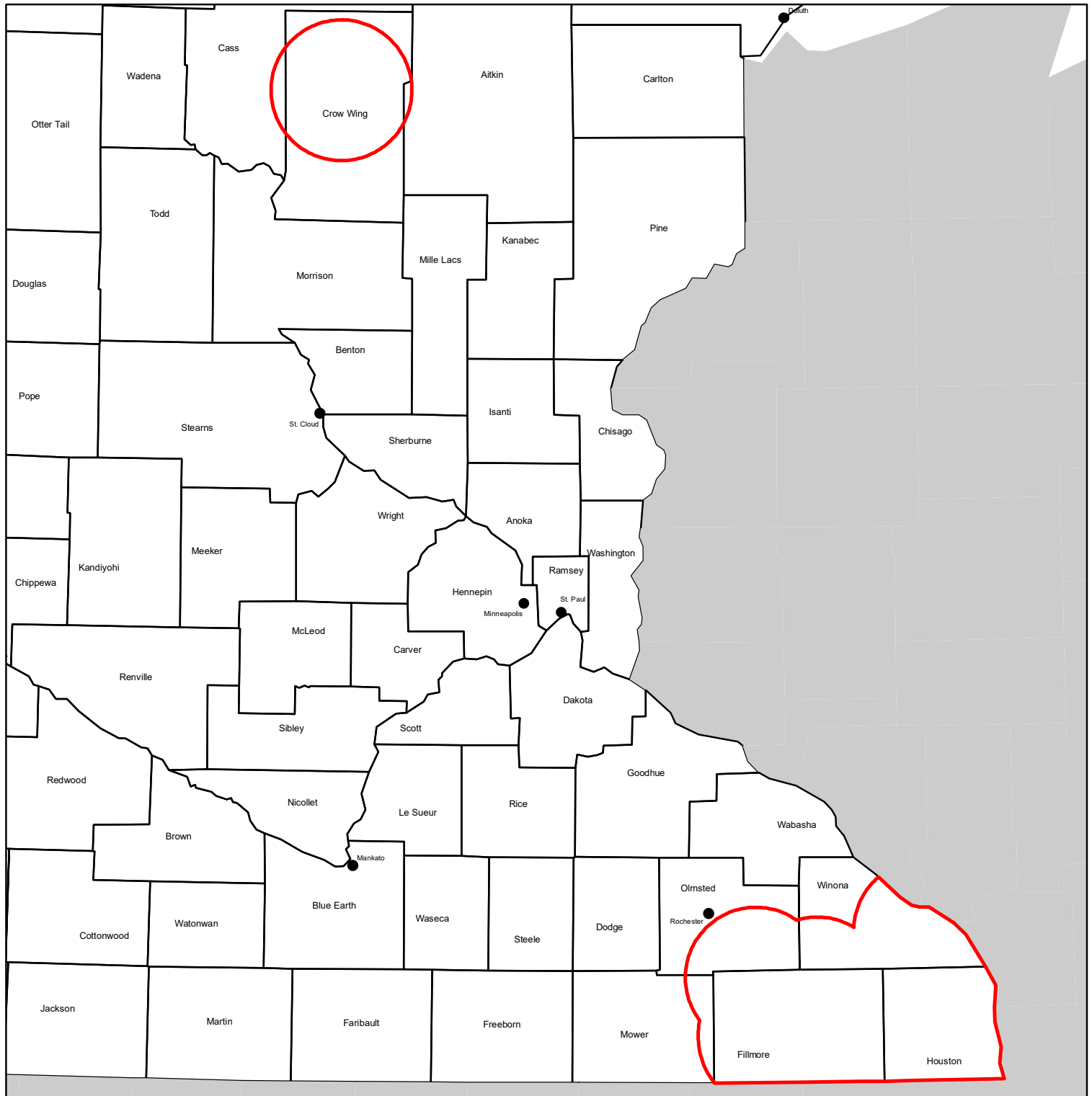
## EXCLUSIONARY FENCING

# Board of Animal Health CWD Endemic Area

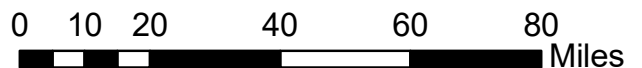


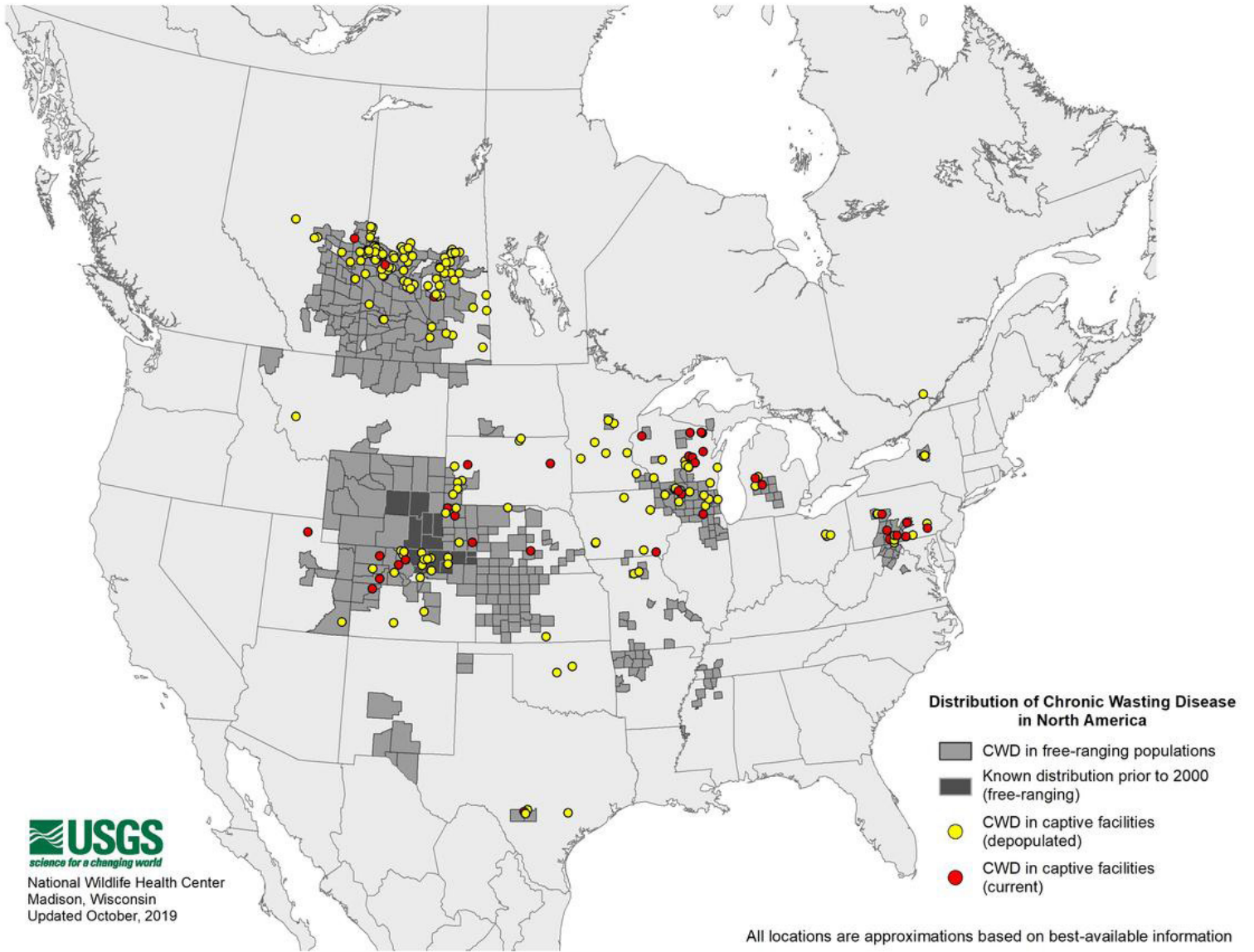
