## Overview

This bill prohibits the sale and use of pesticides containing paraquat dichloride, commonly referred to as “paraquat.” Paraquat is a toxic, widely used herbicide. Paraquat products are categorized as Restricted Use Pesticides under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), so they are restricted to commercial use and may only be used by trained certified applicators.
