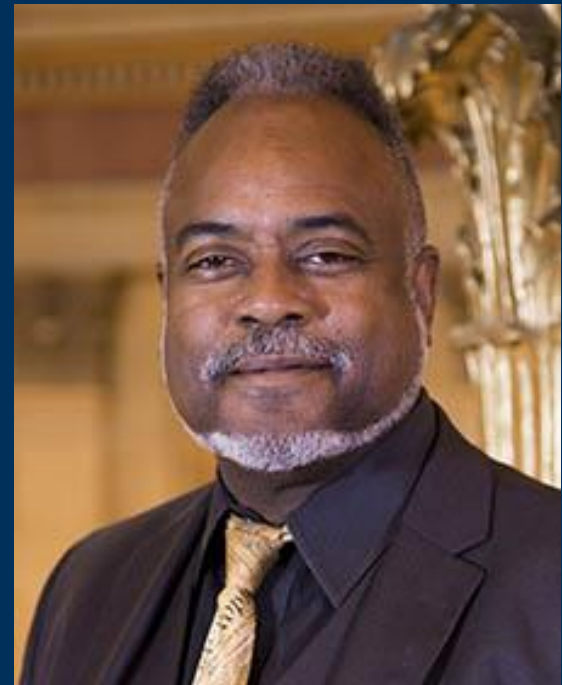

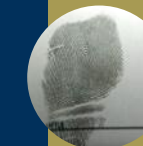

Department of Public Safety

- 1905 The position of State Fire Marshal is created
- 1913 Fire Marshal Department is created
- 1927 The BCA is created
- 1947 BCA lab becomes operational
- 1969 The Department of Public Safety is created**
- 1990 BCA establishes one of the first DNA laboratories in the nation
- 1996 The Alcohol and Gambling Enforcement Division created
- 2003 The Office of Justice Programs created
- 2004 Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management created



Alcohol and Gambling Enforcement



Mission

To protect and serve the public through uniform interpretation, regulation, and enforcement of the state's liquor and gambling laws and rules.

To provide stability and integrity in the alcoholic beverage and gaming industries through the management of licensing, education, regulation, and enforcement.





Alcohol and Gambling Enforcement

Alcohol

- Provides education, regulation, and enforcement of alcohol laws.
- Issues and approves alcohol licenses and permits.
- Conduct pre-license and compliance inspections.
- Investigates trade practice and other industry complaints.





Alcohol and Gambling Enforcement

Minnesota Department of Public Safety

Gambling

- Provides education, regulation, and enforcement of gambling laws.
- Verifies compliance with Tribal/State compacts.
- Investigates and enforces lawful gambling fraud and illegal gambling.
- Conduct background investigations and licensing for the gambling industry.





Alcohol and Gambling Enforcement

Recent achievements –

AGE implemented an updated online liquor license application and renewal process allowing for licensing renewals to be completed automatically.

AGE implemented a Responsible Beverage Service train the trainer grant, to build relationships with the hospitality industry, and providing training in an effort to reduce or the stop over service of alcoholic beverages and prevent youth access.

Recent Achievements –

Supported and convened the work of the Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women Task Force and released the report in December.

Established the Short Term Coronavirus Relief Fund grant program serving 74 organizations throughout Minnesota to address COVID related implications for youth and victim/survivors of crime.

In response to increased isolation of victims of crime during the pandemic, creating a help card translated into 3 languages.

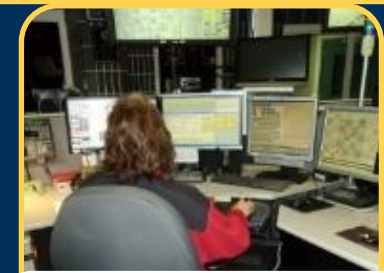

ECN Services – 911

- The 911 Program coordinates the operation and maintenance for 911 call delivery at 102 “911 call centers” across the state
- Contracts with telephone companies to provide 911 network





Emergency Communication Networks

ECN Services

- The ARMER (Allied Radio Matrix for Emergency Response) Program oversees the operation of the public safety radio communication system.
- The Integrated Public Alert and Warning System (IPAWS) program alerts and warning technology by local jurisdictions.
- FirstNet™ provides emergency responders with a dedicated 'fast lane' for mission-critical voice and data communication.





ECN Recent Achievements –

Upgrading to an IP based statewide next generation 911 platform:

- IP network to the call centers
- Statewide Text to 911
- Statewide geospatial data set development

ECN completed a comprehensive Alert, Warning and Notification Best Practices Guide to assist local jurisdictions with writing templates and managing their mass notification systems.

Supported local recoveries and administered assistance in response to three federal and 33 state disaster declarations covering all 11 tribal nations and 87 counties.

Received perfect evaluations during federally-evaluated exercises of the state's capabilities to respond to incidents at the nuclear generating plants in both 2019 and 2020.

Expanded Minnesota School Safety Center capabilities and programs.

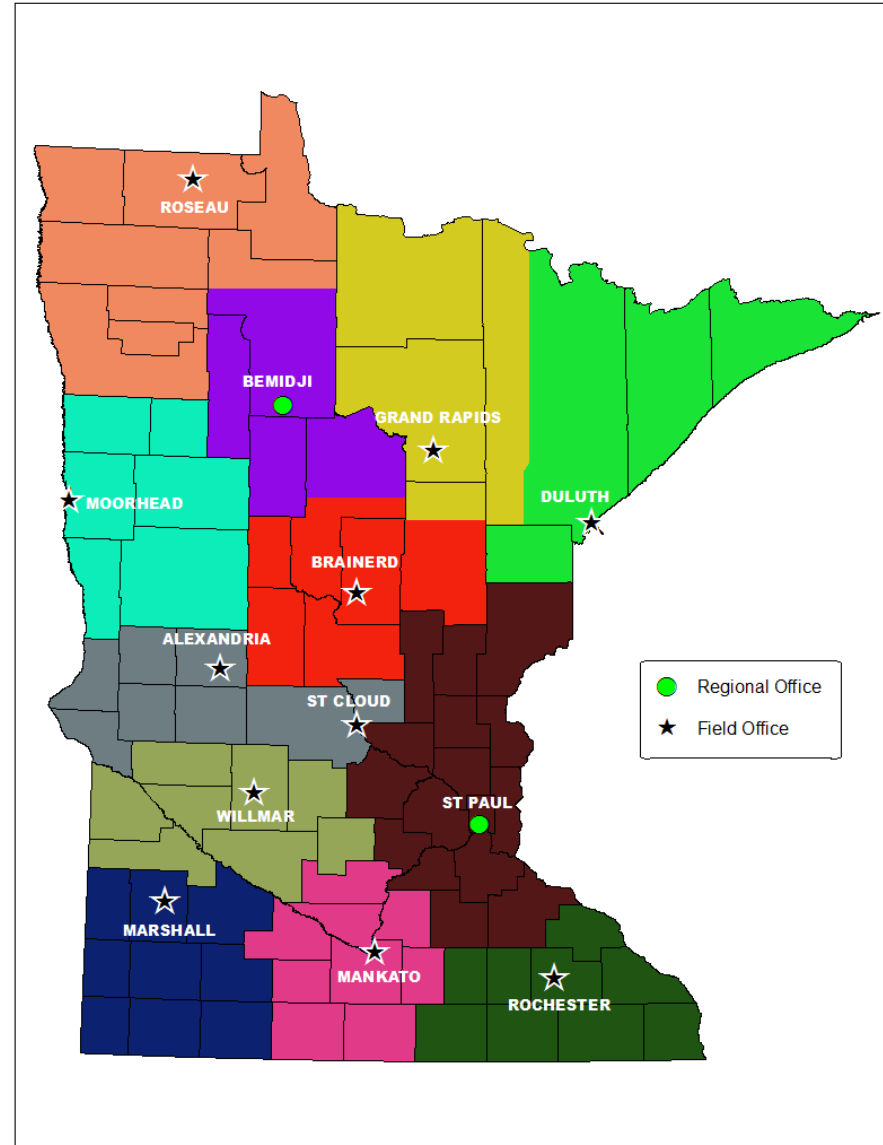
Mission

- 153 Employees (60% IT, 40% Business)

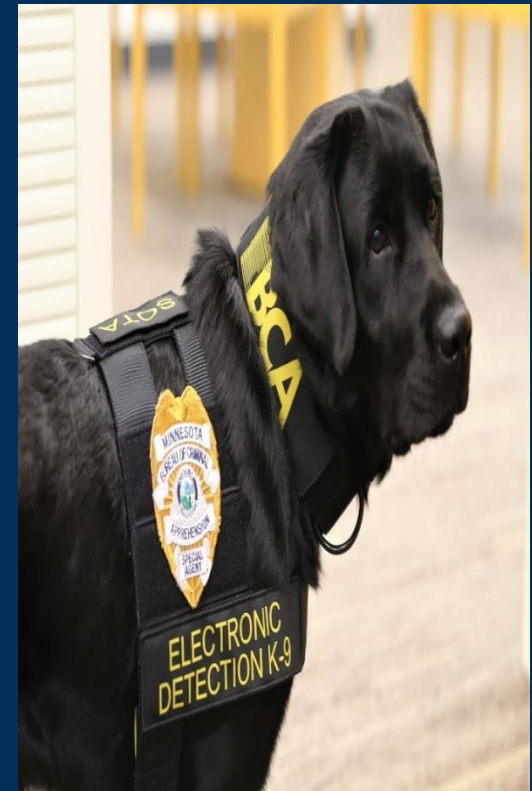


Recent Achievements –

Implemented the first digital evidence K9 in Minnesota aiding investigations to locate all types of digital evidence.

Implemented Deadly Force Encounters Working Group recommendations including a new Use of Force Investigations Unit, and a new Victim, Family, and Community Services program within that unit.

Transitioned state from Uniform Crime Reporting to National Incident Based Reporting statewide finishing a 4 year project and met the FBI deadline for states.
