#### **Bill Description**

This bill would designate the segment of Trunk Highway 28 between the cities of Beardsley and Graceville as the "Staff Sergeant Kevin Witte Memorial Highway". If notified, MnDOT would erect the appropriate signs, with the sign costs to be paid by nonstate sources in accordance with Minnesota Statutes 161.139.

#### Assumptions

There would be a sign required in each direction, or two signs total

Each sign is 4.5 x 4, or 18 sq. ft.

Assume interested groups would pay for the initial fabrication and installation costs

#### Expenditure and/or Revenue Formula

Expenditures

Highway signs:

Fabrication cost of memorial highway sign: \$19.60/sq. ft. x 18 sq. ft. = \$352.80 per sign

Structural materials, equipment, and installation labor costs = \$678 per sign

Total cost per sign = \$352.80 + \$678 = \$1,030.80

Total cost = \$1,030.80 per sign x 2 signs = \$2,061.60 rounded to \$2,100

These costs are based on a technical memorandum for requester pay signs. The costs include MnDOT staff time for engineering, fabrication, and installation of the signs as well as equipment. These costs would be expenditures from the

revolving sign account in the Trunk Highway Fund in FY 2017.

## Revenues

Revenue equal to the amounts of the expenditures would be received in the revolving sign account in the Trunk Highway Fund in FY 2017.

There would be no net fiscal impact to MnDOT.

## **Long-Term Fiscal Considerations**

There would be an ongoing cost for any needed maintenance and eventual replacement of the signs; however, these costs would be paid by interested groups.
