Construction Sales Tax Exemption – HF4114 (Bahner/Robbins)

Dear Rep. Bahner and Rep. Robbins,

As a project with significant regional impact, the North Metro Mayors Association (NMMA) supports the expansion of the North Metro Regional Public Safety Training Facility in Maple Grove and supports exempting the materials and supplies from state sales taxes.

Nineteen agencies, including Joint Powers Agreement partners are dependent on the facility for training, and this success with regional partners makes the training facility not just a regional asset, but a state-wide asset. The legislature recognized this significance by approving Capital Investment funds to assist in funding the expansion and renovation.

As a regional and state-wide asset, it is logical that the project be exempted from sales tax on the materials and supplies purchased with local and state tax dollars.

NMMA is a collaboration of North Metro cities plus community partners working together to encourage private and public investments in the northern suburbs. NMMA member cities include Andover, Anoka, Brooklyn Center, Brooklyn Park, Champlin, Circle Pines, Coon Rapids, Dayton, Fridley, Maple Grove, Mounds View, New Brighton, New Hope, Ramsey, and Spring Lake Park, representing more than 450,000 Minnesota residents.
