1.7 (1) cancer, if the underlying condition or treatment produces one or more of the following:

1.8 (i) severe or chronic pain;

1.9 (ii) nausea or severe vomiting; or

1.10 (iii) cachexia or severe wasting;

1.11 (2) glaucoma;

1.12 (3) human immunodeficiency virus or acquired immune deficiency syndrome;

1.13 (4) Tourette's syndrome;

1.14 (5) amyotrophic lateral sclerosis;

1.15 (6) seizures, including those characteristic of epilepsy;

1.16 (7) severe and persistent muscle spasms, including those characteristic of multiple
1.17 sclerosis;

1.18 (8) inflammatory bowel disease, including Crohn's disease;

1.19 (9) terminal illness, with a probable life expectancy of under one year, if the illness or
1.20 its treatment produces one or more of the following:

1.21 (i) severe or chronic pain;
