Overview

This bill appropriates money from the general fund to the commissioner of human services for grants to Hennepin County to fund emergency shelters and services for homeless persons. It appropriates \$4,000,000 in fiscal year 2022 and \$12,000,000 in fiscal year 2023 and sets the base for this appropriation at \$2,000,000 in fiscal year 2024, \$13,000,000 in fiscal year 2025, \$13,000,000 in fiscal year 2026, and \$13,000,000 in fiscal year 2027.
