Bill Description

HF9059-0 amends Minn. Stat. § 169.444, subd. 2(a), by raising the minimum fine from \$300 to \$500 for the misdemeanor offenses of failing to stop a vehicle or remain stopped for a school bus displaying an extended stop-signal arm and flashing red lights, and passing or attempting to pass a school bus on the right-hand, passenger-door side of the bus when the school bus is displaying the prewarning flashing amber signals.

Assumptions

It is assumed that because the provisions of this bill do not add a new criminal offense, or change the level of offense for existing violation, and only changes the minimum fine, the bill will not result in any increase or decrease in cases filed with the district court or impact the Judicial Branch resources required to process these cases.
