

1.1 ..... moves to amend H.F. No. 2544, the delete everything amendment  
1.2 (A19-0412), as follows:

1.3 Page 13, delete lines 26 to 34 and insert:

1.4 "(f) \$160,000 in fiscal year 2020 and \$160,000  
1.5 in fiscal year 2021 are for two-year Minnesota  
1.6 state colleges that offer farm business  
1.7 management to provide outreach, market, and  
1.8 promote agricultural programming with  
1.9 priority given to beginning farmers, veterans,  
1.10 communities of color, indigenous people, and  
1.11 women. This amount must be divided equally  
1.12 among the eight colleges offering the program.

1.13 (g) \$65,000 in fiscal year 2020 and \$65,000  
1.14 in fiscal year 2021 are for the Minnesota State  
1.15 Southern Agricultural Center of Excellence  
1.16 and the Minnesota State Northern Agricultural  
1.17 Center of Excellence to develop and  
1.18 implement online courses to be offered  
1.19 throughout the state by farm business  
1.20 management programs. This amount must be  
1.21 divided equally between the two centers of  
1.22 excellence. No later than December 15, 2020,  
1.23 the centers of excellence must submit a joint  
1.24 report to the chairs and ranking minority  
1.25 members of the legislative committees with  
1.26 jurisdiction over agriculture, veterans affairs,

- 2.1 and higher education. The report must include
- 2.2 information on the use of money in paragraph
- 2.3 (f) and this paragraph."
