1.2 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

1.3 "Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 8.065, is amended to read:

1.4 **8.065 PRIVATE ATTORNEY CONTRACTS.**

1.5 Subdivision 1. **Contracts exceeding \$1,000,000.** The attorney general may not enter
1.6 into a contract for legal services in which the fees and expenses paid by the state exceed,
1.7 or can reasonably be expected to exceed, \$1,000,000 unless the attorney general first submits
1.8 the proposed contract to the Legislative Advisory Commission, and waits at least 20 days
1.9 to receive a possible recommendation from the commission.

1.10 Subd. 2. **Contingent fee contracts limited.** The attorney general may not enter into a
1.11 contract for legal services on a contingent fee basis if the fees and expenses to be paid by
1.12 the state would exceed, or can reasonably be expected to exceed, the greater of \$100,000
1.13 or two percent of the settlement amount if the matter is resolved in favor of the state.

1.14 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment and
1.15 applies to contracts entered on or after that date.
