a. Special master quick response piece for rebuilding

<u>H. F. 88</u>, (Winkler) A bill for an act relating to state government; establishing a special master panel to make awards to compensate for damages suffered by certain persons resulting from the civil unrest during May and June of 2020; appropriating money.

b. Rebuilding long term development structure

H. F. 85, (Lee) A bill for an act relating to local government; establishing the Metropolitan Area Redevelopment Corporation; providing for certain tax revenues; providing powers and duties to the corporation; requiring a report; appropriating money; amending Minnesota Statutes 2019 Supplement, section 297A.993, subdivisions 1, 2; proposing coding for new law as Minnesota Statutes, chapter 473K.

- **c.** Rebuilding other miscellaneous provisions including eminent domain H. F. 81, (Gomez) A bill for an act relating to local government; authorizing limited use of eminent domain; authorizing a development moratorium in certain areas.
- 4. <u>H. F. 124</u>, (Nash) A bill for an act relating to elections; modifying requirements related to the release of election results at the 2020 state primary and state general elections.
- 5. <u>H. F. 116</u>, (Dehn) A bill for an act relating to public safety; restoring the civil right to vote of an individual upon release from incarceration or upon sentencing if no

incarceration is imposed; requiring notice; amending Minnesota Statutes 2018, sections 201.014, by adding a subdivision; 201.071, subdivision 1; 609.165, subdivision 1; Minnesota Statutes 2019 Supplement, section 204C.10; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapters 201; 243.

- 6. <u>H. F. 39</u>, (Klevorn) A bill for an act relating to state government; establishing observance of India Day; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 10.
- 7. Adjournment.
