Parent Aware Rated Programs by Program Type Over Time

Some types of child care and early education programs have been participating in Parent Aware statewide since 2012: public school prekindergarten programs meeting School Readiness Standards, Head Start/Early Head Start programs and accredited licensed child care programs. For non-accredited licensed child care programs, Parent Aware was available in eight counties in 2012. In the subsequent years, counties were incrementally added, with all counties eligible to participate in January 2015. Both the staggered start and voluntary nature of Parent Aware has impacted the growth pattern for non-accredited programs.
