2.5 report must include:

2.6 (1) the amount of each expenditure;

2.7 (2) the purpose of each expenditure;

2.8 (3) the number of staff engaged in contact tracing, case investigation, and follow-up
2.9 services under the program, broken out by state staff; local health department, community
2.10 health board, and tribal health department staff; and volunteers; and

2.11 (4) any additional information that the commissioner determines may assist the legislature
2.12 in understanding the progress of these efforts."

2.14 Page 3, delete section 2 and insert:

2.15 "Sec. 2. **TRANSFER TO PUBLIC HEALTH RESPONSE CONTINGENCY**
2.16 **ACCOUNT.**

2.17 The commissioner of management and budget shall transfer \$300,000,000 in fiscal year
2.18 2020 from the fund in the state treasury where funds received under the Coronavirus Aid,
2.19 Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act, Public Law 116-136, title V, have been
2.20 deposited, to the public health response contingency account under Minnesota Statutes,
2.21 section 144.4199. Notwithstanding the authorized purposes specified in Minnesota Statutes,
2.22 section 144.4199, subdivision 1, the commissioner must use this transfer for purposes of
2.23 section 1. This is a onetime transfer. Of this amount:

2.24 (1) up to \$3,000,000 is for short-term staffing to support the current case investigation
2.25 and contact tracing strategy;

2.26 (2) up to \$4,000,000 is for transfer to tribal nations in Minnesota to support their contact
2.27 tracing, case investigation, and follow-up efforts;

2.28 (3) up to \$30,000,000 is for transfer to local health departments and community health
2.29 boards to support their contact tracing, case investigation, and follow-up efforts conducted
2.30 in coordination with the Department of Health and to support their community education,
2.31 outreach, and case management efforts within their communities;

- 3.1 (4) up to \$5,000,000 is for a public information campaign;
- 3.2 (5) up to \$30,000,000 is for information technology needed to support the new case
- 3.3 investigation and contact tracing strategy; and
- 3.4 (6) up to \$228,000,000 is to contract for or to hire, train, and support temporary employees
- 3.5 and volunteers for purposes of this section.
- 3.6 Notwithstanding the maximum expenditure amounts specified in clauses (1) to (6), the
- 3.7 commissioner may make expenditures in amounts that exceed the amounts specified in one
- 3.8 or more of those clauses, provided the commissioner reports on those expenditures under
- 3.9 section 1, subdivision 5."
