Dear Chair Liebling and Committee Members:

We, the undersigned mental health and substance use disorder treatment programs in Minnesota, and affiliated associations and partners, express our support for the inclusion of HF 3153 (Morrison) in the House Health Finance bill.

This language (Article 3, Sec. 25) would expand the types of providers that can be reimbursed to provide tobacco treatment (education and counseling). Providers would include, but is not limited to, mental health practitioners, mental health professionals, mental health certified peer specialists, alcohol and drug counselors, recovery peers and community health workers. The bill would also remove barriers, such as prior authorization or quantity limits, to the use of FDA-approved medications used in tobacco treatment for Medical Assistance and MinnesotaCare enrollees.

In support of integrated care, health equity, improved mental health and substance use disorder recovery, a reduction in tobacco addiction and a reduction in tobacco-related illness and deaths, please support this legislation.
