Summary

This bill modifies the deadline for the chief judge of a district to appoint charter commission members. Under current law, if the chief judge fails to appoint charter commission members within 30 days, the city council may appoint them. However, if during the 30 days the chief judge indicates to the city council that the judge intends to appoint new charter commission members, then the judge has 60 more days in which to make the appointments.

The bill would give the chief judge 60 days to appoint new or reappoint existing charter commission members.
