1.5 "Sec. 7. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 609.2245, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.6 to read:

1.7 Subd. 4. Penalties. (a) A person who violates subdivision 1, paragraph (a), may be
1.8 sentenced to imprisonment for not more than five years or a payment of a fine of not more
1.9 than \$10,000, or both.

1.10 (b) A person who violates subdivision 1, paragraph (b), may be sentenced as follows:

1.11 (1) if the act results in narrowing of the vaginal orifice with creation of a covering seal
1.12 by cutting and appositioning the labia minora, or both, imprisonment for not more than 20
1.13 years or to payment of a fine of not more than \$30,000, or both;

1.14 (2) if the act results in partial or total removal of the clitoris and the labia minora,
1.15 imprisonment of not more than ten years or payment of a fine of not more than \$20,000, or
1.16 both;

1.17 (3) if the act results in partial or total removal of the clitoris, prepuce, or both,
1.18 imprisonment of not more than five years or a payment of a fine of not more than \$10,000,
1.19 or both; or

1.20 (4) if the act constitutes a harmful procedure to the female genitalia not described in
1.21 clauses (1) to (3), including, but not limited to, pricking, piercing, incising, scraping, and
1.22 cauterization, imprisonment of not more than five years or a payment of a fine of not more
1.23 than \$10,000, or both.

- 2.2 applies to violations committed on or after that date."
