Bill Description

This bill provides for a secondary unit within the current Lake Vermilion-Soudan Underground Mine State Park. This designation of a state recreation area will allow OHV travel on designated trails and on park roads that provide ingress or egress to overnight facilities.

Assumptions

Since the bill only establishes a new unit, we don't anticipate any revenue or operational changes at this time.

Signage and maps will need to be updated and changed to reflect those portions of the area that are changing to a state recreation area.

Expenditure and/or Revenue Formula

On average when redoing signs and maps for a new area the costs are about \$15,000 through the DNR sign procurement process and staff within Parks and Trails updating maps. This includes boundary postings, maps, and informational signs.

Long-Term Fiscal Considerations

The change in designation will allow the design and construct of future OHV facilities and trails in this new designation area. Funding will be needed and requested when appropriate for operations, construction, signage, and maintenance of these facilities and trails.
