"Section 1. [626.8474] INVESTIGATING SEXUAL ASSAULT CASES; POLICIES REQUIRED.

- (a) By December 15, 2019, the chief law enforcement officer of every state and local law enforcement agency must develop, adopt, and implement a written policy governing the investigation of sexual assault cases within the agency. In the development of a policy, each law enforcement agency shall consult with local sexual assault counselors, domestic abuse advocates, community organizations, and other law enforcement agencies with expertise in the recognition and handling of sexual assault cases. A law enforcement agency may adopt the model policy created by the board in lieu of developing its own policy under this provision. At a minimum, a law enforcement policy must address each of the procedures covered in the board's model policy. The chief law enforcement officer must ensure that each peace officer investigating a sexual assault case follows the agency's policy.
- (b) Every state and local law enforcement agency must certify to the board by December 15, 2019, that it has adopted a written policy in compliance with this subdivision.
- (c) The board must assist the chief law enforcement officer of each state and local law enforcement agency in developing and implementing policies under this subdivision."
