1.2 Page 6, after line 13, insert:

1.3 "Sec. .... Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 256B.04, subdivision 24, is amended to read:

1.4 Subd. 24. **Medicaid waiver requests and state plan amendments; public comments;**  
1.5 **termination of Medicaid programs or benefits.** (a) The commissioner shall notify the  
1.6 chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over  
1.7 medical assistance at least 30 days before submitting a new Medicaid waiver request to the  
1.8 federal government.

1.9 (b) Prior to submitting any Medicaid waiver request or Medicaid state plan amendment  
1.10 to the federal government for approval, the commissioner shall publish the text of the waiver  
1.11 request or state plan amendment, and a summary of and explanation of the need for the  
1.12 request, on the agency's website and provide a 30-day public comment period. The  
1.13 commissioner shall notify the public of the availability of this information through the  
1.14 agency's electronic subscription service. The commissioner shall publish the text of all  
1.15 public comments on the agency's website and consider public comments when preparing  
1.16 the final waiver request or state plan amendment that is to be submitted to the federal  
1.17 government for approval.

1.18 (c) The commissioner shall also publish on the agency's website notice of any federal  
1.19 decision related to the state request for approval, within 30 days of the decision. This notice  
1.20 must describe any modifications to the state request that have been agreed to by the  
1.21 commissioner as a condition of receiving federal approval.

1.22 (d) The commissioner shall not take the following actions without prior enactment of  
1.23 legislative authorization:

1.24 (1) terminate a Medicaid program, waiver, or benefit;

- 2.1 (2) request federal assistance with terminating a Medicaid program, waiver, or benefit;

- 2.3 (3) substantially redesign a Medicaid program, waiver, or benefit.
- 2.4 **EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.**

- 2.6 Amend the title accordingly
