2.31 8, paragraph (b), and licenses issued under section 97B.301, subdivision 4.

3.1 (b) \$2 from each annual deer license and \$2 annually from the lifetime fish and wildlife
 3.2 trust fund, established in section 97A.4742, for each license issued under section 97A.473,
 3.3 subdivision 4, shall be credited to the deer management account and is appropriated to the
 3.4 commissioner for deer habitat improvement or deer management programs.

3.5 (c) \$1 from each annual deer license and each bear license and \$1 annually from the
 3.6 lifetime fish and wildlife trust fund, established in section 97A.4742, for each license issued
 3.7 under section 97A.473, subdivision 4, shall be credited to the deer and bear management
 3.8 account and is appropriated to the commissioner for deer and bear management programs,
 3.9 including a computerized licensing system.
