1.6 Subd. 5b. Penalties for moratoria on residential construction. Notwithstanding
1.7 anything in this section, the Department of Revenue must not pay aid under this section to
1.8 a city that imposes a moratorium on new residential developments. The Department of
1.9 Revenue must stop issuing payments to the city in the year after the city adopts a resolution
1.10 or ordinance imposing the moratorium. The Department of Revenue may begin issuing
1.11 payments to the city in the year after the moratorium expires or in the year after a resolution
1.12 or ordinance to end the moratorium takes effect. During the period in which a city is not
1.13 receiving aid pursuant to this subdivision, the Department of Revenue must pay the amount
1.14 that the city would have received under this section in the absence of this penalty to the
1.15 county or counties containing the city. In the annual report required under subdivision 6, a
1.16 tier I city must certify whether it has in effect a moratorium on new residential developments.
