### **Bill Description**

• Appropriates money from the clean water fund to adopt rules establishing water quality standards for perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA) and perfluorooctanesulfonic acid (PFOS)

Onetime appropriation available until June 30, 2023.

#### **Assumptions**

1. This is assumed to be a major rulemaking, so expenditures were estimated based on a rulemaking of similar scope and size as laid out in the Minnesota Rulemaking Manual and adjusted based on MPCA's past rulemaking experiences.

2. Costs were apportioned across fiscal years depending on timing of process steps. Since this is a new numeric water quality standard, peer review is required, per statute.

#### Expenditure and/or Revenue Formula

#### Non-Staff Costs:

1. Office of Administrative Hearing costs (filing fees associated with the eComments site, Administrative Law Judge review time, hearing costs) = **\$40,000 total (FY22)** 

- 2. State Register costs (publication of all associated notices) = \$6,000, or \$3,000 in FY21 and \$3,000 in FY22
- 3. Attorney costs for rulemaking \$131/hour for 86 hours = \$11,266 or \$5,633 in FY21 and \$5,633 in FY22

#### MPCA Staff Costs:

1. Rule coordinator staff (**0.75 FTE/year** x \$124,000 x 2 years) = \$186,000 or **\$93,000 in FY21** and **\$93,000 in FY22** 

2. Water program staff (**1 FTE/year** x \$124,000 x 2 years) = \$248,000 or **\$124,000 in FY21** and **\$124,000 in FY22** 

# **Total Costs**

- FY2021 = \$225,633, 1.75 FTE
- FY2022 = \$265,633, 1.75 FTE

\*The annual cost of 1.0 FTE is \$124,000 in FY2019-2023. Annual costs for 1.0 FTE include salary, fringe, and non-specialized employee support costs (work space, computer and office supplies, office equipment, local travel, etc.).
