Bill Description

A planning group is established to conduct a community needs assessment and advise the legislature on the legal and policy issues associated with the decriminalization of mental illness. The group shall study and review the barriers, best practices and strategies for addressing disparities in the criminal justice system and barriers to accessing the courts for persons with mental illness.

The Commissioner of Administration (Admin) shall convene the first meeting of the group no later than September 1, 2020. The Commissioner or designee will serve as the group's chair until a chair is elected by the group. Admin will provide three administrative support staff for the working group and arrange meeting space.

The planning group has reporting responsibilities and expires the earlier of December 2, 2025 or the day after the group submits a final report as required by the bill.

Assumptions

We assume the following:

- Planning group will meet quarterly.
- Admin would provide two State Program Admin Seniors and one OAS Intermediate beginning July 1, 2020 to provide administrative support to the group.
- Administrative support includes assisting the planning group with needs assessment, research, analysis, planning, policy and rule drafting/development, report writing, clerical support, and additional tasks as needed.
- Planning group will continue its work beyond the time frame reported in this fiscal note.
- Costs for supervision of new staff and Admin Commissioner's time to serve as initial group chair will be absorbed.

Expenditure and/or Revenue Formula

Starting salaries for the three positions to be added are estimated at step 7 of the respective salary ranges.

Bill Description

The proposed legislation would establish a planning group to decriminalize mental illness.

Assumptions

The commissioner of corrections, or a designee, would serve as a member of the planning group.

The commissioner of corrections would be responsible to appoint two individuals with mental illness who have experience with correctional residential settings to be members of the planning group.

Members of the group will serve without compensation or reimbursement of expenses.

It is assumed the commissioner and/or a designee would assume the membership role as part of their position responsibilities.

Section 1, Subd. 8 requires the commissioners of public safety and corrections to "take immediate corrective action to remedy critical problems" identified in a report by the planning group to the Legislature on or before December 1, 2022. The cost of any "immediate corrective action" cannot be estimated, and is not provided in this fiscal note.

Section 1, Subd. 9 requires the planning group to submit a report to the commissioner of corrections no later than December 1, 2025 that includes suggested rules, and requests the commissioner to act within existing rulemaking authority. The cost related to rulemaking cannot be determined at this time, and is not provided in this fiscal note.

There are no criminal charges in this bill.

There would be no impact to prison beds or supervision caseloads statewide.

This bill would become effective the day following final enactment.

Long-Term Fiscal Considerations

The findings and recommendations within the required reports could result in the need to incur costs for "immediate corrective action to remedy critical problems", and also the need to incur costs related to rulemaking. Without knowing

what the reports may include, it is impossible to determine the extent of those potential costs. Cost estimates are not provided for the purposes of this fiscal note.
