1.5 "Sec. 64. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 299D.03, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.6 to read:

1.7 Subd. 2a. **Salary survey.** (a) By February 15 annually, the state auditor must conduct
1.8 a compensation survey of law enforcement officers in every police department:

1.9 (1) in a city with a population in excess of 25,000, located in a metropolitan county, as
1.10 defined in section 473.121, subdivision 4, that is represented by a union certified by the
1.11 Bureau of Mediation Services; or

1.12 (2) in a city of the first class.

1.13 The survey must report on the previous calendar year. The survey must be based on full-time
1.14 equivalent employees. The state auditor must calculate compensation using base salary and
1.15 premium pay. Premium pay is payment that is received by a majority of employees and
1.16 includes, but is not limited to, education pay and longevity pay. The state auditor must not
1.17 include pension contributions and benefits when determining compensation. The survey
1.18 must identify the seven highest paid police departments in the state and the average
1.19 compensation of the seven departments.

1.20 (b) By February 15 of each year, the state auditor must transmit a copy of the survey to
1.21 the chairs, ranking minority members, and staff of the legislative committees with jurisdiction
1.22 over the State Patrol budget, the exclusive representative for members of the State Patrol,
1.23 and the commissioner of management and budget. The state auditor must prescribe the
1.24 format of the survey."
