Bill Description

The bill would exempt licensed family child care providers and licensed child care centers from Minnesota Rules, chapter 9544, relating to positive support strategies and restrictive interventions.

Assumptions

It is assumed that the Department of Human Services Licensing Division would continue to inspect licensed child care centers but would not apply the requirements of Minnesota Rules, chapter 9544. It is assumed that counties, through delegated authority from the commissioner, would continue to inspect licensed family child care homes but would not apply the requirements of Minnesota Rules, chapter 9544. It is assumed that these changes would not result in any cost to either the Department or counties.

The effective date of this section is the day following final enactment.
