

Subject Vehicle registration validation stickers

Overview

This bill eliminates required display of validation stickers on motor vehicle license plates (which show the month and year of the valid registration period). It also makes technical changes related to plate display. Effective October 1, 2026.

Article 1: License Plate Stickers

This article removes required validation sticker issuance and placement on plates. It makes technical changes, to centralize plate display provisions.

Section Description – Article 1: License Plate Stickers

- 1 Plates; design, visibility, periods of issuance.**
Eliminates a requirement that the Department of Public Safety issue registration validation stickers. Makes technical changes.
- 2 Registration and plates required.**
Establishes that validation stickers are not required to be displayed on a license plate unless required in specific circumstances. Makes technical and conforming changes, which includes eliminating language on plate display that is substantially reproduced in another subdivision.
- 3 Plate fastened and visible.**
Makes technical changes, which include centralizing license plate display requirements by reproducing language eliminated in another subdivision.
- 4 Repealer.**
Repeals provisions on license plate design and validation sticker placement that are made obsolete by the changes in this article.

Article 2: Conforming Changes

This article makes conforming changes to remove references to validation stickers, and makes some technical changes.
