Dear Chair Lee, Ranking Minority Leader Urdahl, and Members of the Committee,

On behalf of Greater Mankato Growth, the Chamber of Commerce and Economic Development Organization representing more than 900 members in the Greater Mankato region. I write in support of the \$10,000,000 bonding request of the city of North Mankato for the Caswell Regional Sporting Complex (HF97/SF2348). Fully funding this project would represent an important investment in a critical regional recreation facility that will help ensure our region has the amenities needed to support regional livability as well as talent growth, retention, and attraction.

The mission of Greater Mankato Growth (GMG) is to support and promote the economic growth and vitality of our members and the regional marketplace.
