## **Bill Description**

Bill provides funding to BWSR to work in cooperation with the UofM Water Resources Center (MN Office for Soil Health) to develop a state soil health action plan. The plan must be submitte to the chair and ranking minority members of the House of Representatives and senate committees and divisions with jurisdiction over agriculture and environment and natural resources by January 15, 2020. It is a onetime appropriation.

#### **Assumptions**

This work would be done in cooperation with the Minnesota Office for Soil Health at the University of Minnesota Water Resources Center over an 18-month period of time. The development of the plan will include a robust/diverse participant process, professional facilitation services, plan writing, and staff charges for personnel from BWSR and the MN Office for Soil Health at the University of Minnesota Water Resources Center for their work.

#### Expenditure and/or Revenue Formula

\$150,000 cost based on:

7 participant meetings @ 2500/mtg = \$17,500

Mtg facilitation = \$45,000

Misc Exp (travel, supplies, etc.) = \$6,000

One-time staff charges (BWSR & UofM) for plan development, research, writing, outreach, etc. = \$81,500
