Page 67, delete subdivision 2, and insert:
"Subd. 2. Voluntary certification program; best management practices. (a) The commissioner of the Pollution Control Agency must develop a training program that promotes best management practices to reduce the use of salt to protect water quality, for removing snow and ice safely, and for applying salt and other deicers. The commissioner must allow individuals who are commercial applicators to obtain certification as a water-friendly applicator. The commissioner must certify an individual who is a commercial applicator as a water-friendly applicator if the individual successfully completes the program and passes the examination.
(b) The commissioner, in consultation with the University of Minnesota, must provide additional training under this subdivision for certified commercial applicators renewing certification after their initial training and certification.
(c) The commissioner, in consultation with the University of Minnesota, must provide the training and testing module at locations statewide and may make the recertification training available online.
(d) The commissioner, in consultation with the University of Minnesota, must annually post the best management practices and a list of certified commercial applicators on the agency's Web site.
(e) The commissioner may charge a fee of no more than $\$ 250$ per certified commercial applicator for the training or recertification under this subdivision. Fees collected under this subdivision must be deposited in the environmental fund."

Page 68, after line 21, insert:
"Subd. 7. Expiration. This section expires August 1, 2025."
