To follow up on your request for more information following our presentation on the Governor's Office budget, please see the information below and attached.

The purpose of the Special Revenue Fund is to provide funding for the dues to the National Governor's Association, the Midwestern Governor's Association and the National Lieutenant Governor's Association, as well as funding for staff members who provide direct service to agencies. The amount of funds in the Special Revenue Fund in 2004 was \$261,000.

The average rate of compensation for our staff is \$67,433.89.

I have attached a spreadsheet with specific amounts per Agency paid into the Special Revenue Fund from 2012- 2017.
