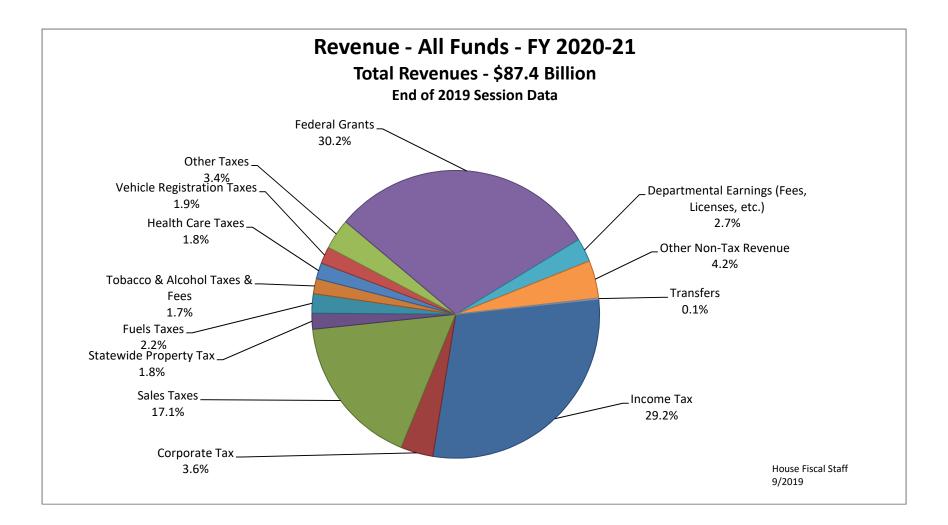

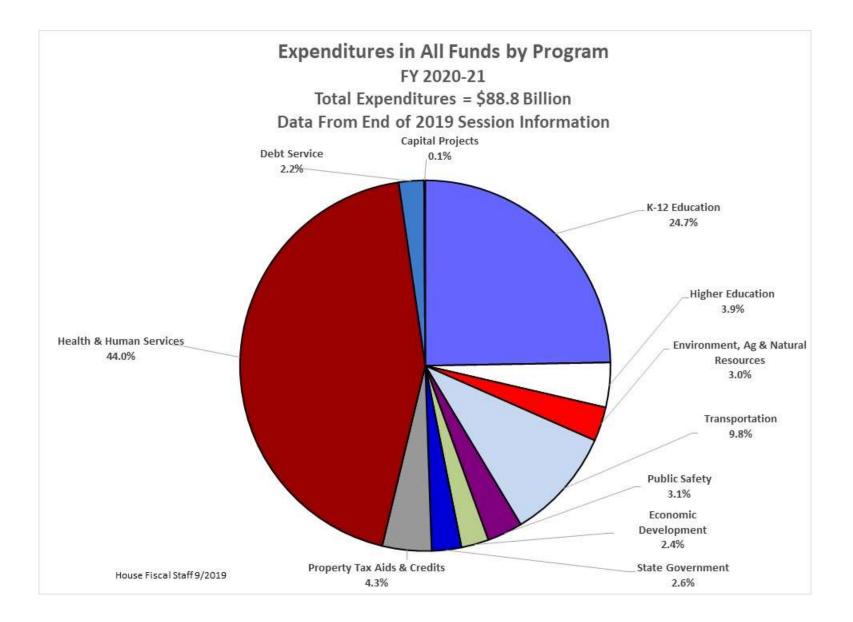


Budget Basics:

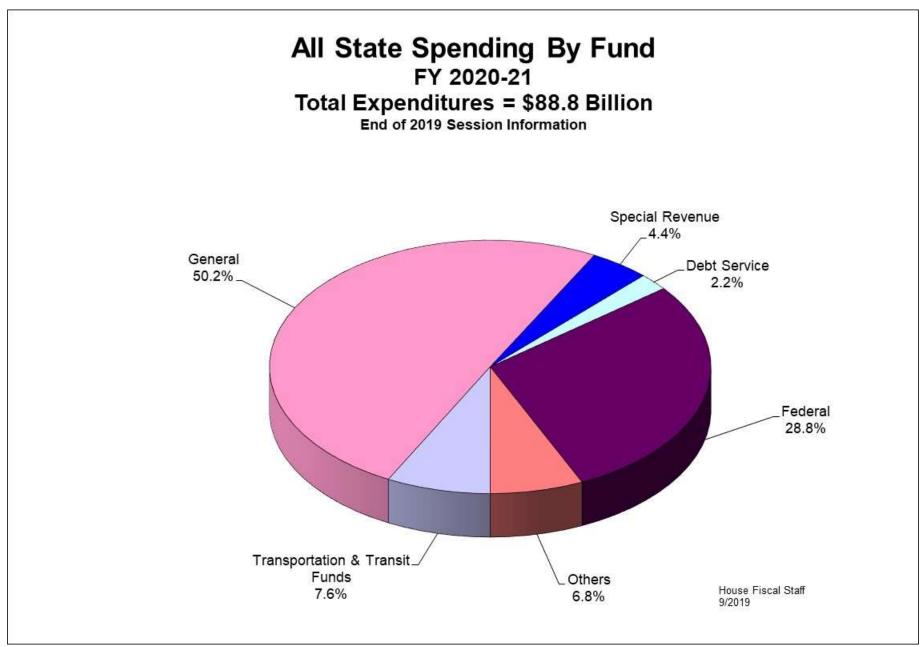
- □ The state fiscal year goes from July 1 to June 30. The fiscal year starting July 1, 2019 is fiscal 2020 (FY 2020).
- The state budgets on a biennial basis. A biennium is two fiscal years.
 FY's 2020 and 2021 make up the current biennium that started July 1, 2019 and ends June 30, 2021.
- The 2019 Legislature adopted a budget for the FY 2020-21 biennium (July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2021). The 2020 Legislature may make adjustments to that budget.

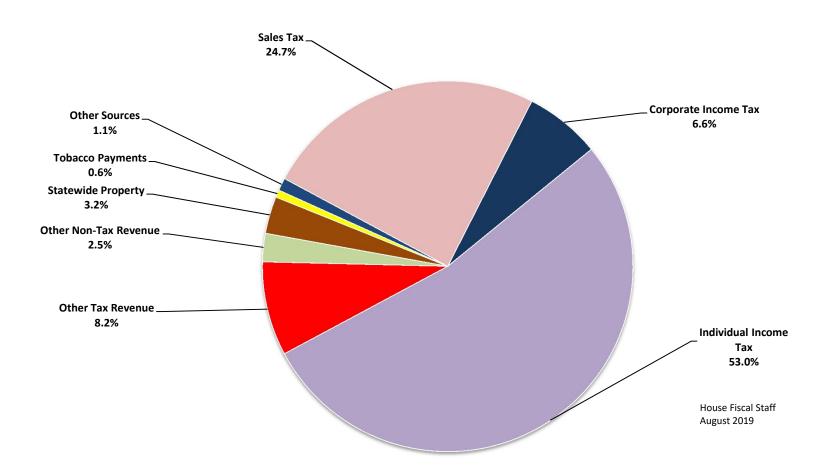

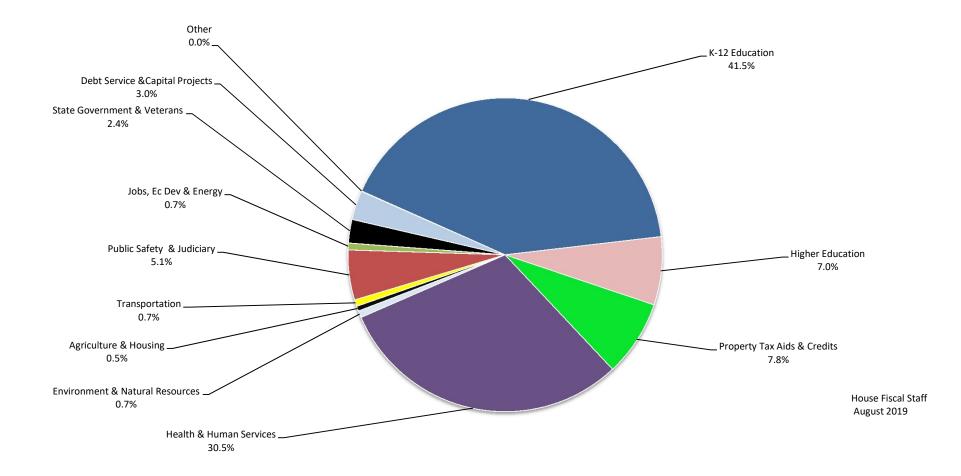

Current General Fund Budget Situation

- As of the end of the 2019 legislative session, the FY 2018-19 biennium was projected to end with a \$606 million general fund balance.
- □ FY 2019 revenue was \$636 million more than forecasted. Within that amount income taxes were up \$450 million. Spending will be less than forecasted increasing the FY 2019 ending balance. Final FY 2019 spending and revenue information will be released with the November forecast.
- □ In the first two months of FY 2020 revenue has been \$83 million more than forecasted.
- At the end of the 2019 session the FY 2020-21 biennium was projected to end with a balance of \$242 million. That includes the \$606 million carried forward from FY 2019.
- □ A large share of Minnesota revenue is dependent on economic changes (income tax, corporate income tax, sales tax).
- □ The state's budget reserve is now at \$2.075 billion. In addition, a cash flow account has \$350 million. A MMB report recommends a budget reserve at 5.0% of revenue or \$2.408 billion. At the time of the November forecast, 33 percent of any FY 2020-21 balance will be transferred to the budget reserve.



November 2019 State Budget Forecast

- The next state budget forecast will be released by Minnesota Management and Budget (MMB) in late November or early December, 2019.
- This forecast will provide final revenue and spending numbers for the biennium that ended June 30, 2019 (FY 2018-19) and update projected revenue and spending for the current biennium (FY 2021-21) and update the planning estimates for the next biennium (FY 2022-23).
