1.5 Subd. 11. **Licensing orders; grounds; reapplication.** (a) The commissioner may  
1.6 deny an application for a permit, license, registration, or certificate if the applicant does  
1.7 not meet or fails to maintain the minimum qualifications for holding the permit, license,  
1.8 registration, or certificate, or has any unresolved violations or unpaid fees or monetary  
1.9 penalties related to the activity for which the permit, license, registration, or certificate has  
1.10 been applied for or was issued.

1.11 (b) The commissioner may deny, suspend, limit, place conditions on, or revoke a  
1.12 person's permit, license, registration, or certificate, or censure the person holding or acting  
1.13 as qualifying person for the permit, license, registration, or certificate, if the commissioner  
1.14 finds that the person:

1.15 (1) committed one or more violations of the applicable law;

1.16 (2) submitted false or misleading information to the state in connection with  
1.17 activities for which the permit, license, registration, or certificate was issued, or in  
1.18 connection with the application for the permit, license, registration, or certificate;

1.19 (3) allowed the alteration or use of the person's own permit, license, registration,  
1.20 or certificate by another person;

1.21 (4) within the previous five years, was convicted of a crime in connection with  
1.22 activities for which the permit, license, registration, or certificate was issued;

1.23 (5) violated: (i) a final administrative order issued under subdivision 7, (ii) a final  
1.24 stop order issued under subdivision 10, (iii) injunctive relief issued under subdivision 9,  
1.25 or (iv) a consent order or final order of the commissioner;

2.1 (6) failed to cooperate with a commissioner's request to give testimony, to produce  
2.2 documents, things, apparatus, devices, equipment, or materials, or to access property  
2.3 under subdivision 2;

2.4 (7) retaliated in any manner against any employee or person who is questioned by,  
2.5 cooperates with, or provides information to the commissioner or an employee or agent  
2.6 authorized by the commissioner who seeks access to property or things under subdivision 2;

2.7 (8) engaged in any fraudulent, deceptive, or dishonest act or practice; or

2.8 (9) performed work in connection with the permit, license, registration, or  
2.9 certificate or conducted the person's affairs in a manner that demonstrates incompetence,  
2.10 untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility.

2.11 (c) If the commissioner revokes or denies a person's permit, license, registration,  
2.12 or certificate under paragraph (b), the person is prohibited from reapplying for the same  
2.13 type of permit, license, registration, or certificate for at least two years after the effective  
2.14 date of the revocation or denial. The commissioner may, as a condition of reapplication,  
2.15 require the person to obtain a bond or comply with additional reasonable conditions the  
2.16 commissioner considers necessary to protect the public.

2.17 (d) If a permit, license, registration, or certificate expires, or is surrendered,  
2.18 withdrawn, or terminated, or otherwise becomes ineffective, the commissioner may  
2.19 institute a proceeding under this subdivision within two years after the permit, license,  
2.20 registration, or certificate was last effective and enter a revocation or suspension order as  
2.21 of the last date on which the permit, license, registration, or certificate was in effect."
